Q WHAT ARE THE NEWEST ADVANCES IN COSMETIC SURGERY?

A There are many recent advances in cosmetic surgery and non-surgical cosmetic procedures. Less extensive or minimally invasive cosmetic surgery procedures can save recovery time and side effects, and often improve results. The uses of various injectable tissue fillers or a patient's own fat to correct changes of facial aging have been a very beneficial adjunct to surgical methods of cosmetic enhancement.

A medically based therapeutic skin-care program that is Botox injectable with high-tech, non-invasive applications of light and radio-wave energy for facial rejuvenation are exciting, recent non-surgical tools for reversing effects of aging on the face. Advances in body contouring and breast enhancement surgical techniques, including the recent FDA-approved silicone gel breast implants, have also greatly increased the plastic surgeon's ability to help patients meet their goals of achieving their best appearance.
